## Renovating your historic home? Two ways to save money. \*

Program	Bailey Bill	State Income Tax Credits
How does it save me money?	"Freezes" the assessment value of your home for 20 years.	Gets you state income tax credits worth 25% of the costs of your home's eligible renovations
	Note: Although millage rates are subject to increase over time, the property's value will be assessed at the pre-rehabilitation rate.	Example: Spend \$20,000 on approved renovations. Subtract \$5000 from your state income taxes. Spread the credit over 3 to 5 years.
How much do I have to spend?	At least 20% of the home's assessed value spent on eligible renovations within two years of certification  Example: Your home is assessed at \$200,000 and the eligible renovations cost at least \$40,000. (Personal labor does not count.)	At least \$15,000 spent over 36 months on eligible renovations  Note: Your personal labor is <b>not</b> counted toward the \$15,000 minimum.
Who can apply?	Homeowners of contributing houses in Columbia's Cottontown Architectural Conservation District	Homeowners of contributing houses in the Bellevue Historic District (National Register)
What are eligible renovations?	Exterior repairs and structural rehabilitation  Examples: Roof, attic insulation, furnace / AC, wiring, plumbing pipes and sanitary sewer, repointing bricks, replacing rotting wood siding or exterior trim, supporting sagging floors, painting exterior wood, repairing historic windows & doors, repairing historic plaster, addng storm windows, architectural and engineering fees.  Note: New additions are <b>not</b> eligible expenses, but are reviewed in the application.	
How do I get started?
